### **Baptism of the Lord**

### Year A

### 12<sup>th</sup> January 2020



The feast of the Baptism of the Lord is also the last day of the Christmas season.

Celebrations of the Lord's baptism first appeared in the east.

On January 6th, the date of the winter solstice, the Church there commemorated the Epiphany, or manifestation, of Christ. Unlike the Western Church, which focused its celebration of the coming of Christ solely on his nativity, the feast in the Eastern Church recognised three aspects of the revelation of Jesus as the Son of God: his birth, his baptism by John in the Jordan, and his first miracle at the wedding feast in Cana.

Water is the central symbol in the celebration of baptism. Water signifies washing. We are weak human beings, prone to sin. God's mercy and grace alone can wash us clean of our sinfulness. Because water is essential to all life, the water of baptism also symbolises the life-giving grace that sustains those who have become children of God.

Another important symbol in the celebration of baptism is the presence of the Christian community which gathers to welcome a new member.

Baptism is not a private family occasion; it involves incorporation into the Body of Christ, being made a part of the community of faith.

Oil is used twice in baptism. First the chest is smeared with the oil of catechumens as a sign of healing and strengthening. Afterwards the head is anointed with perfumed chrism as a sign of gladness and thanksgiving. The white garment with which the newly baptised is then clothed symbolises being enveloped by Christ and is "the outward sign of Christian dignity". A baptismal candle is lit from the paschal candle beside the font and presented to the new member as an image of the light of Christ. It is to be "kept burning brightly" and lit again on significant anniversaries and sacramental

In the opening prayer of Mass today we are reminded our baptismal commitment: your children reborn of water & Holy Spirit be pleasing to you (Liturgy Lines)



### Thomas Sherratt accepted into NET for 2020



Dear Friends,

My name is Thomas Sherratt.

I am very excited to share with you the news of my year ahead. I have accepted a volunteer position with NET Ministries for the year of 2020. NET Ministries is the National

Evangelisation Team. The group consists of 40-50 young people aged between 18 and 30. Various teams will travel around Australia and New Zealand to different diocese running retreats, youth groups, young adult discussion groups and university ministries. It is an opportunity for us to help fulfil the mission of NET by sharing the message of Jesus to the youth.

NET Ministries reaches out to more than 30,000 young people across Australia every year with the life changing message of Jesus Christ. For those of you who may not know me I am John Foxon. You might recognise me from doing the reading sometimes at Sunday evening masses or you may have seen me attending the morning mass at St Catherine's.



I am writing to share with you some exciting volunteer work I will be starting next year. Come January next year I will be a full-time volunteer with **NET Ministries Australia**.
