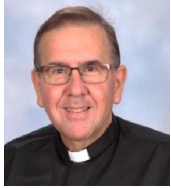

### Our Pastor's Message

#### Month of the Holy Rosary & Praying the Rosary

Dear Parishioners,

The Rosary invites us to remember the great mysteries of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. We honour the Virgin Mary as a prayerful, reflective person. In the second chapter of his gospel, Luke says of her that she “treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart.” Again, in response to what Jesus said to her in the temple, Luke says that Mary “treasured all these things in her heart.” She was a contemplative person, reflecting on all that was happening in the life of her Son. To that extent, she embodies the attitude of mind and heart that we are invited to bring to praying the Rosary. In that prayer, we treasure and ponder upon the key moments in the journey of Jesus in this world and from this world to the Father.

Mary pondered on what God was doing in the words and deeds of her Son, and gave herself over to the guidance of the Spirit, as shown by her response to the visit of Gabriel in Luke’s gospel, “Let what you have said be done to me” or “Let it be to me according to your word.” As we ponder on all God is doing in the words and deeds of Jesus, we too will hear the call to give ourselves over more fully to God’s purpose for our lives.

**Your Financial Giving to the Parish**
