Parish Christmas Hampers

The parish is conducting the Christmas Hamper Appeal again this year. The Appeal will be launched on the weekend of the **7/8 November** at all the Parish Masses. The process will be slightly different this year because of the caution we have to take concerning COVID-19. However, we are relying on your usual generous spirit to help some of the many families in need.

The current circumstances vis a vis changes in available support for needy families as well as COVID cautionary behaviour have led us to modify our usual process after discussion with the SVDP Conferences in Toowoomba and Inala.

This year we will not have lists of particular families for you to select from, and we will not be requesting hampers filled with non-perishable food items and gifts. Instead, we are requesting **gift cards only** so that the SVDP conferences we work with can configure the donations for the size of each family being supported.

We aim to support 80 families from Toowoomba, Bush Connection (now *Toowoomba Integrated Family Support*), and Roma, slightly fewer than last year. We also aim to support 20 families from Inala. The Inala donations will be handled primarily through the OLR School community from whom we are requesting donations of hamper items and gifts. The Inala conference will configure hampers appropriate for each family from these donations. Similar to last year, we also plan use any excess donations to assist the Emmanuel City Mission for the homeless (previously Blind Eye Ministries).

There are several ways for you to donate:

- **Donation of gift cards** – our aim is **\$250 for each nominal family** (\$200 for food items and \$50 for a Christmas gift). It helps the SVDP conferences if the gift cards are in \$50 denominations, but this is not a requirement. They have requested that we preferably purchase *gift cards without liquor outlets* listed on the back of the cards. Donations for Roma recipients are to be Woolworths or IGA Gift Cards only. For the other recipients, gifts cards for Coles or Aldi are also accepted.
- **Cash donations**
- **EFTPOS** via the Parish Office in person or by phone

- **Direct Deposit Donations to the Parish Bank Account** – to be identified as “Hamper Appeal”, “Hampers ROMA”, or if for a particular family (see below) “Hampers TWBA 1”

Please note that donations must be designated for the Hamper Appeal to distinguish them from regular Parish Giving. The new Pay-wave option in the Churches cannot be used for the Hamper Appeal.

Instead of our usual Hamper Table, we will have lists of nominal families from each group for you to select from. This will help us keep track of the anticipated response. The lists will be on the notice board at the entry to the Church. You will not have to provide your name and contact details. Just remove the tab(s) for the chosen family and pick up a Hamper Appeal envelope. You can choose to provide full or partial support, depending on how many tabs you take for the family. If you are not using electronic transfers, **return your donation to the regular Parish Giving Box in the Church or drop it off at the Parish Office**. Please place the colour-coded tab(s) in the envelope or write the selected family or area (e.g., TWBA 1) on the envelope.

Whichever way you choose to donate, please provide or return donations by **Monday 30th November 2pm**. As every year, your generosity to the Hamper Appeal will be greatly appreciated.

Just to remind Parishioners that the Parish Hamper appeal can NOT give a Tax deductible receipt for any money the Parish receives.

If parishioners require a Tax deductible Receipt we suggest that they wait to contribute to the St Vincent De Paul Christmas Appeal in December.

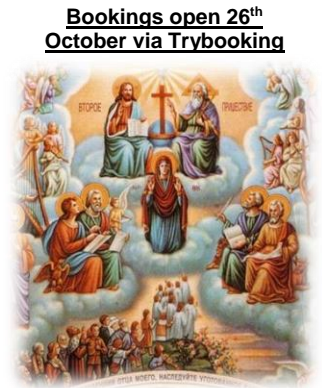
