#### **Our Pastor's Message**

Dear Parishioners.

Today's Feast of All Saints is less concerned with the canonised saints than all the good and holy people who have lived.

None of us, I feel sure, are aspiring to be or

expecting to be a canonised saint.

We don't dream that one day the Pope will tell the world what saints we were. We don't kid ourselves that our picture is going to pop up one day on the walls of churches. Not for a moment do we imagine anyone saying prayers to us or carrying around pieces of us as relics. We don't foresee any statues of us being carried high in processions. But in its document on the Church, the Second Vatican Council wrote a chapter called The Universal Call to Holiness. So surely our Feast today is reminding us of our deep-down longings to become better people than we currently are!

Surely too it is reminding us that Jesus Christ can and will empower us to practise what he preached and to live what we believe!

Surely, then, we won't ever want to stop striving to live our lives in the Kingdom of God with a Community of living saints. As we come to the Altar all we ask, as St Monica asked, to be remembered at the Altar of the Lord.

On the Feast of All Souls and the month of Holy Soul's we remember many whom we have known and loved — family members and good friends and the wider circle of everyone we have met in life, who have passed on. Indeed, the whole month of November is especially devoted to remembering our dead. This is a prayerful remembering in our Book Of Life, keeping their memory in our hearts, while we seek God's presence. Praying for our loved ones expresses our ongoing communion with them.

We commit all who have gone ahead of us to God, who also accompany us on our journey of life. Our communion in the church keeps us in fellowship with all who have died. Praying for them, we ask that they may have life, as the Lord brought the widow's son to life. We are also grateful to them, thanking God for the gift of their lives and all the ways we were blessed through them. All Souls, we entrust them all to God. As "God's love has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given to us," we pray that they now experience God's love to the full. God Bless, Fr Mark

# **Parish Christmas Hampers**

The parish is conducting the Christmas Hamper Appeal again this year. The Appeal will be launched on the weekend of the **7**<sup>th</sup>/**8**<sup>th</sup> **November** at all the Parish Masses. The process will be slightly different this year because of the caution we have to take concerning COVID-19. However, we are relying on your usual generous spirit to help some of the many families in need. After discussion with the SVDP Conferences in Toowoomba and Inala, we are requesting **gift cards** and **donations only**.

There are several ways for you to donate:

- Donation of gift cards our aim is \$250 for each nominal family (\$200 for food items and \$50 for a Christmas gift). It helps the SVDP conferences if the gift cards are in \$50 denominations, but this is not a requirement. They have requested that we preferably purchase gift cards without liquor outlets listed on the back of the cards. Donations for Roma recipients are to be Woolworths or IGA Gift Cards only. For the other recipients, gifts cards for Coles or Aldi are also accepted.
