St Catherine's Mass Centre Update

With Fr Mark away on retreat this week we've replaced his pastoral column with some news on the progress of the landscaping at St Catherine's as part of the development agreement with the new Moggill Shopping Village.

As you are aware the development of the shopping centre required access across the rear of our property in order for them to connect to the sewer system.

As such the developer was required to "make good" all excavated areas, following consultation and design discussions the outcome has provided some wonderful improvements including:

- new COLORBOND® fencing for the length of the western boundary
- additional storm water drainage with rubble run off areas
- a compacted access driveway at the back of the property
- large levelled and turfed areas beside and behind the Mass Centre
- landscaped garden beds planted with native shrubs along parts of the fence line and on the battered slope too steep to turf

Some works are still to be completed with our own sewer connection waiting on approvals from Urban Utilities, which should come through soon. We also plan to erect a new garden shed, away from the newly landscaped areas, to provide storage for various equipment previously kept in the container and donga which were removed.

We trust the Parish community are happy with these outcomes which will greatly enhance our Moggill property.

Covid Restrictions Update

For all Masses, the following restrictions currently apply:

- **Masks must be worn in our Churches and buildings**
 - Clergy and readers who are socially distanced from others may remove their masks while speaking and then put it back on.
- **Attendance capacity under the 1 person per 4 square metre rule limits numbers to 70 worshippers at both Kenmore & Moggill Churches.**
- **All attendees will be required to check in on arrival using the Qld Government's Check in Qld App.**
