# **Pastor's Message**

Jesus' message was new and shocking for the religious Monday 21st February leaders of his day. Their law decreed "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth." In other words, they were expected to strike back at those who harmed them in any way. It is in a gospel like that presented to us today that we see just how radical and revolutionary Jesus' teaching must have sounded back then. Indeed, it is still quite revolutionary in today's world, with our dog-eatdog mentality. The process of salvation which he had come to establish would be based on forgiveness, and, therefore, to be part of, and to belong to that process must put each of us right Out there in the front line of tolerance, forgiveness, and love.

Look in a mirror, reflecting on the failures and sin in your Friday 25th February life. Take as much time as you need. You are going to ask God's forgiveness, you are going to offer amendment, to move forward from here. Jesus taught us one simple prayer, which we call the Our Father or the Lord's Prayer. It is a simple prayer, and it is quite short. One of the petitions is where we ask God to forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. We can rattle off this prayer, and fail to realise the bind in which it can place us.

In the Lord's Prayer, we ask God to forgive us on one condition, which is that we will forgive others in our turn. There is a proven power in forgiveness and love. "Blessed are the meek" says Jesus, "they shall possess the earth." We are impressed by the power of forgiveness shown by characters like Mahatma Ghandi, Martin Luther King, and others who somehow managed to turn the other cheek. The bully cannot deal with the power of the one who won't strike back, but often resorts to violence as the only way to silence their voice of protest. To err is human, to forgive is divine. We would aim to be big-hearted, tolerant and patient.. But the ideal Jesus sets for us is, "Be merciful, just as your heavenly Father is merciful." God Bless, Fr Mark

# **QLD Check In App & Chapel Access Update**

Following advice from the Queensland State Government, we are no longer required to use the Qld Check In App in our churches, the parish office and the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. All Parish buildings, Churches, Chapel, meeting rooms and offices will no longer display the Qld Check In App QR code.

With these changes we will also be loosening some of the restrictions on the use of the Blessed Sacrament Chapel at Kenmore as follows:

- We will revert to our pre Covid practice of opening the main entry of the Chapel when the Parish office is open, so all can come and go for private devotion on weekdays during office hours.
- You are no longer required to check in via the office.
- Masks are required to be worn and hand sanitiser used on entry and exit.
- 1 person per 2sqm occupancy limit and 1.5m distancing applies.
- You are asked to wipe down the pew you have used with the disinfectant wipes provided before you leave.
- All those wishing to access the Chapel after hours will need to contact the Parish Manager to complete the necessary safeguarding requirements before being issued with an access code.
