Pastor's Message

In today's world it's hard to find a little peace and Monday 28th February quiet in order to meet oneself and God.

It's not easy to avoid the constant harassment of all kinds of calls and messages. The worries and hurry of each day take up our whole attention. Not even in our own home, pervaded by television and digital Wednesday 2nd March - Ash Wednesday media, is it easy to find the tranquillity and recollection we need to joyfully relax with God.

Have we forgotten what it means to pause, interrupt our hurry, free our minds for a few moments and let ourselves be penetrated by the silence and calm of sacred space? Often, it's enough to stand still and be silent for a short time, in order to quiet the spirit and recover peace. How much we need to find the silence that helps us to enter into contact with our very selves in order to recover our freedom and to rescue once again all our inner energy.
