Pastor's Message

St Paul says that at the end of time Jesus Christ will hand Monday 21st November - The Presentation of the over the kingdom to God the Father. Our Preface at Mass this weekend for the feast of Christ the King repeats this. describing the kingdom as one of truth and life, of holiness and grace, of justice. love and peace.

This vision is something to be promoted by us in the present. The kingdom is our hope, but it is also in our midst, in process of becoming. Jesus tells us how to promote the coming of God's kingdom among us. It comes closer Wednesday 23rd November whenever justice is done for the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, and the oppressed.

To act in this way is to imitate the Shepherd-King himself who rescues us from situations of alienation, who feeds, gives rest, heals and makes strong. At the end he was promising the thief being crucified at his side, that he would be enter into paradise.

The best way to honour Christ our King as we celebrate this great Feast this weekend is to work to develop his project of mercy among us. Whatever we do to help the deprived and underprivileged is also a service to Christ, who identifies himself personally with people in need.

Following Christ the King is not the passive option of "keeping myself to myself" or "I do harm to anyone." To Saturday 26th November ignore the needs of our neighbour is to close our ears to Christ.

To turn aside from the anguish of the dying is to shut our eyes to him. If we follow Jesus Christ as our Shepherd-king we must in some way be shepherds ourselves, for his sake.
