Pastor's Message

This month of September we are focusing on Readers of the Word. The second Vatican Council reminded us of the central place of scripture in public worship: 'Christ is present in his word since it is he himself who speaks when the holy Scriptures are read in the Church' and 'The Church is nourished spiritually at the table of God's word and at the table of the Eucharist', for example.

The only contact that many Catholics have with the living word of scripture occurs at Sunday Mass. It is vital that this encounter be a positive experience so that they will develop over time a 'warm and living love of scripture'.

Those who are called to be readers at Mass, then, take on an important ministry. In fact, they are not 'readers' at all. Almost everyone can read, but what is happening at Mass is proclamation the Word of God. Those people who serve the liturgical gathering by proclaiming the scriptures are best described as 'ministers of the word'.

Carrying out the role well requires faith in the Word of God, a love of scripture, thorough preparation and the skills needed for reading aloud in public.

Proclaiming the Word is a two way process which requires attentive listeners for it to be effective. We will hear the Word of God better if we prepare by reading the texts before coming to Mass then put our Missals aside during the Liturgy of the Word and engage in dialogue with the word. Readers are channels of God's word.

The Parish is entering a time to renew the Liturgical Ministers at Eucharist.

I invite you to consider becoming one of the Readers of the Word at weekend Masses. To register please contact the Parish office, fill in a registration form available at both churches or complete the online form at https://forms.office.com/r/mmKahhtHMx There will be a training session for new and current readers in the future and other resources to assist those who proclaim the word. So please consider becoming a Reader of the Word at Mass to help other love and pray the scriptures at Mass. God Bless, Fr Mark

Living Laudato Si' in Our Parish

At our most recent Parish Finance Council meeting a proposal to install a 19kW solar panel array on the office roof at Kenmore was approved. This project has been in the planning since late last year, following the replacement of the office roof, which was identified as an ideal location for solar panels. This system will service the power needs of both the parish office and Our Lady of the Rosary Church and has been designed to offset our daytime power usage in these two buildings. In doing so we will eliminate the majority of our largest electricity cost in the parish, and we will take a great step forward in our environmental sustainability, reducing our carbon footprint by saving over 21 tonnes of CO2 from being released into the atmosphere each year, according to estimates. We are most grateful to a generous donor who has provided the funding to enable this important initiative which will provide significant financial and environmental savings long into the future for our Parish. Installation is expected from mid-September, and we will update you as things progress, for more information please contact the Parish manager.
