Pastor's Message

In today's gospel reading, Peter, James and John are taken up a high mountain by Jesus, and there they have an experience of Jesus which took their breath away. It was an experience that was so precious that Peter could not let it go. He wanted to prolong it indefinitely and so he says to Jesus, 'Rabbi, it is wonderful for us to be here, so let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah'. He and the other two disciples had a fleeting glimpse of the heavenly beauty of Christ, and did not want to let go of it. Beauty always attracts; it calls out to us. Yet, Peter and the others had to let go of this precious experience; it was only ever intended to be momentary. They would receive it back in the next life as a gift. For now, their task was to listen to Jesus, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to him'. That is our task too. We spend our lives listening to the Lord as he speaks to us in his word and in and through the circumstances of our lives; we listen to him as a preparation for that wonderful moment when we see him face to face in eternity and we can God Bless, Fr Mark finally say, 'it is wonderful to be here'.

Ronita is 22. She lives with her husband and two children in a barangay (local district) in Quezon City, which is situated in Metro Manila in the Philippines. Ronita left school when she became pregnant as a teenager. This could have had a life-long impact on her ability to find work and provide for her family but, thankfully, she heard about the Alternative Learning System (ALS) program run by the Faithful Companions of Jesus (FCJ), Caritas Australia's local partners in the Philippines. Through the FCJ, Ronita was able to re-enrol in her studies and continue learning in a safe and flexible environment – even with the arrival of her second child. After completing her ALS classes, Ronita went on to earn her Grade 12 Senior High School Diploma. With her new diploma, Ronita has now secured a job at a call centre and is looking to a brighter future for her whole family. "I have now graduated senior school and I am so proud of myself." she said. "I feel hopeful for the future... Now it's not impossible for me to achieve my dream... Thank you." St Stephen's Cathedral 150th Anniversary Message Stick to Visit Western Deanery

The Message Stick is an ancient and culturally significant instrument of welcome which began its journey through the deaneries of the Archdiocese of Brisbane in August 2023. The Message Stick holds an invitation to attend the 150th Anniversary of the completion and opening of St Stephens on the sacred lands of Meanjin Brisbane at Pentecost 2024. The symbol on the right of the Message Stick denotes a meeting place and the feet and serpent on the left represent moving to the meeting place. For the next three weeks the Message Stick will be travelling through Brisbane West deanery. It commenced with a moving reception at the Parish school on Friday morning and will be received this Sunday afternoon by Darra Jindalee Parish. It will then return to Kenmore where it will be received at a Parish Mass on the following weekend. Stay tuned for updates on the travels of the Message Stick around our Deanery.
